PREAMBLE

The State of Karnataka contributes around 40% of the Indian biotechnology sector. The State has remained one of the major investment destinations in the biotech industry. To boost the growth of biotechnology sector, the Government of Karnataka has announced Millennium Biotech Policy – II in 2010 wherein one of the objectives is to increase the quality of human resources by supporting specific educational and research institutions including BT Finishing Schools. The Government of Karnataka has also come out with Start-up policy (2015 – 2020) for IT & BT and identified Healthcare and Bio Pharma, Agriculture and allied fields, Clean-Tech, Energy, Nanotechnology and Composites as focus areas and continues the leadership position of Bengaluru as Start-Up City.

2. As per Millennium Biotech Policy – II, Government of Karnataka in 2010 announced setting up of the Biotechnology Finishing Schools (BTFS) BTFS with appropriate course content and duration to equip graduates and post-graduates, with necessary employable skills to make them job-ready. The first of its kind initiative was envisioned to bridge the gap between industry requirements and quality of students by providing students the experience of real-life industry-oriented experience working on problems which are not taught-in-depth in regular academic curriculum.

3. BTFS programme was started in 2011 at twelve (12) host institutions in Karnataka and have been offering PG Diploma courses since then. The programme has gained popularity amongst the biotechnology and life science students across India. The companies associated with programme for providing internship and placement has also increased steadily from year to year. So far over 800 students have taken up the course with placement record of ~75%.

4. After 5 years of successful implementation the BTFS programme, there is a need to have skill-based curriculum and aligning it with National Vocational Educational Quality Framework (NVEQF) or National Skill Quality Framework (NSQF) of National Skill Development Council. This need is felt much more in biotech Industry with requirement of trained manpower at different job levels. Also, keeping in mind the changing aspirations of young India and renewed focus of the programme, the scheme as Biotechnology Finishing School programme is re-named as “**Biotechnology Skill Enhancement Programme (BiSEP)**”. The department intends to closely associate with Life Science Sector Skill Development Council or organisations empanelled with NSDC in designing course curriculum and assessing the student’s skill sets acquired thus aiming to make the students employable or self-employable by the time they complete the course under BiSEP.

5. A call for expression of interest has been floated for the selection of fifteen institutions with necessary infrastructure etc for hosting the BiSEP. A selection committee is required to be setup to finalise selection of institutions. Hence, the order.


